
Publishing in a hybrid open access journal



For agreements that include publishing in hybrid open access journals, authors will follow this series of steps to publish under the terms of the agreement.

Article Post-Acceptance (Publication)



After the article is accepted, authors (specifically the corresponding author indicated during submission, though co-authors may be invited in to check the progress towards publication) will be asked to register or log in with Wiley Author Services in order to complete steps for license signing and publication.



Create Account




Upon logging in to Author Services, the author will see their article, a timeline/tracker of the current article status, an eligibility message regarding APC funding (if they entered their affiliations during submission), and any open actions to be completed.





They start the post-acceptance process by clicking the Sign License button. (Alternately, they could click the Select Open Access button – both buttons lead authors into the same set of steps.)

The corresponding author is then shown the Confirm Author Roles step and confirms one or more corresponding authors for publication:



Next, the author moves on to the Responsible Corresponding Author (RCA) step and chooses one RCA:



Identifying the appropriate RCA aims to improve the identification of authors eligible for APC coverage through a WOAA or TA and reduces the number of funding requests requiring transfer between institutions. It also aligns author data across multiple publication workflow steps and ensures that any changes to corresponding author roles during the peer-review process are captured in the data.

Depending on the choice of RCA:

- a) Author chooses self as RCA and continues on to Funder/Grant Details step
- b) Author selects someone else as the RCA. The RCA is emailed and logs in, then starts at the Funder/Grant Details step

Funder and grant details

The RCA then confirms original research funders for all authors named on this article. If they have entered this information on submission, it will be displayed here and they won't need to enter it again. If they need to add or edit any funder or grant details, they can use the typeahead search to find the relevant funding agency and specify grant numbers and recipients.

1. At the top, the institution has been Verified as recognized in the Ringgold database, and it also displays messaging that this institution has an open access agreement with Wiley, in order to prime the author on their open access APC coverage.

2. Next, an affiliation has been entered that has been Verified within Ringgold, but does not have an open access agreement.

3. Lastly, if the author enters an institution that is Not Verified, it means it's not been found within Ringgold.

The Help with affiliations section on the right sidebar is available to help users understand what they're seeing on screen and how to enter their affiliations so they're recognized by the system. We also reassure authors that this information is solely used to identify their eligibility for open access coverage and doesn't affect any information on the published article.

If the author needs to add additional affiliations, the typeahead search results auto-populate below for authors to choose from. (This information comes from the Ringgold database.) We also use previous affiliation entries from the author's profile, as well as geolocation, to show the most relevant search results first.

Open Access Selection

Authors then are asked whether they would like to publish their article open access. Here, again, the eligibility message is shown to reinforce that their APC will be covered by the agreement with their institution.

Authors do have the option to keep their article subscription only, but the most prominent choice is to accept the open access coverage offer.
